### TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

All Canadian, British & US citizens must have a valid passport to enter into Peru. Citizens of other countries should check with the Peruvian Embassy/Consulate for details on Visa requirements.

Passports must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the period of intended stay with at least 2 free pages in the visa section when entering Peru.

Please Note: The name on your ticket must EXACTLY match that of your passport or boarding may be denied. If you have a middle name or initial on your passport, please ensure it appears on your ticket as well.

Always carry your documents, tickets, medication and valuables with you while travelling. They should not be packed with your checked luggage. They should be carried with you while travelling.

Unless insured, your baggage is transported at your own risk. It is recommended that you pack a change of clothing in your carry-on luggage in the event of mis-routed or delayed luggage.

## MEDICAL INFORMATION

Please ensure that you have consulted with your medical doctor or travel clinic for appropriate inoculations, such as **Yellow Fever and Malaria medications** for those travelling to the Amazon, as well as Altitude Sickness. **Cusco is at 3,399 m (11,150 ft.), which can be a challenge for some. NB: Our rooms at the Belmond Monasterio are enriched with oxygen** to combat the effects of Cusco's high altitude.

These precautions are to ensure nothing prevents you from having the time of your life on this magical journey!

## AIRPORT CHECK-IN

Please ensure you check-in at the airport at least 3 hours prior to your departure time.

It is recommended you call the Airline Information Number or check online to verify your flight times. Due to increased airport security measures, please be sure to leave ample time for check in as late arrivals could be denied boarding. Please also confirm that your frequent flyer number (if applicable) is on file upon check-in.

## LUGGAGE ALLOWANCE

Economy Ticket Holders:

**Carry-On:** Passengers are allowed one carry-on bag plus one personal item such as a purse, briefcase, laptop or backpack. Passengers will be required to check any bags above this allowance. Please check with your airline(s). The maximum size of carry-on luggage for all airlines is 40cm X 55cm X 23cm. Any objects such as razors, tweezers, nail files, scissors or pocket knives are not allowed in your carry-on luggage. You are allowed to bring a quart-sized bag of liquids, aerosols, gels, creams and pastes in your carry-on bag. These are limited to travel-sized containers of 3.4 ounces (100 mls) or less per item.

**Checked Luggage:** Due to recent changes in luggage allowances with all airlines, we recommend that you check the airline website for exact luggage allowances for your flights, as well as associated costs for checked luggage.

**NOTE: Baggage allowance for the internal Peru flights is 23 Kgs (50 lbs.)**

In the unlikely event that your luggage is misdirected, please report it at the Lost Luggage Counter before leaving the airport.

## LUGGAGE TAGS

Please ensure your luggage is tagged with your name prior to departure from your home. These tags will expedite the identification and safe handling of your luggage at the hotels.

---

## SECURITY CONSIDERATIONS

The following are a few tips to help ensure safe travels. It is recommended that you limit the amount of valuables you bring with you. **While traveling it is best to keep valuables, jewelry, travel documents and medications with you or locked in your hotel in-room safety deposit box.** Do not place these items in your checked luggage or leave them in locked luggage or loose in your hotel room.

With respect to air transportation, never leave your luggage unattended and never, ever agree to carry on items, packages or suitcases for other people. Report any such requests to airline personnel or your travel staff immediately. While on the program, be sure to follow the instructions of the travel staff regarding luggage and movements within the airport.

## WEATHER

The average temperatures in Peru in September vary widely depending on the location. In **Lima** the average high is 19° Celsius (66° Fahrenheit) and evening low is 13° Celsius (55° Fahrenheit). In the **Sacred Valley/Cusco** the average high is 20° Celsius (68° Fahrenheit) and evening low is 4° Celsius (39° Fahrenheit) due to the altitude. In the **Amazon** the average high is humid 30° Celsius (86° Fahrenheit) and evening low is 22° Celsius (71° Fahrenheit).

## TIME DIFFERENCE

In September, Peru is 1 hour behind Toronto and all cities on EST and 6 hours ahead of London (UTC/GMT).

## AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Round-trip transfers for those flying will be provided between the Lima International Airport and the Belmond Miraflores Park Hotel, the Cusco International Airport and the Belmond Rio Sagrado Resort/Belmond Montasterio Hotel and from the Iquitos Airport to the Delfin Embarkation Pier in Nauta.

## CURRENCY

The currency in Peru is the Sol (PEN) and the exchange rate at time of printing is 1 Sol = \$.40 CDN. We suggest you purchase a small amount of Soles before you arrive. ATM's are readily available in the hotels and Lima and credit cards are widely accepted in cities and major shops. **You will have opportunities to purchase local handicrafts in rural communities, which accept CASH ONLY.**

---

## ELECTRICITY/VOLTAGE

Standard North American voltage is 120V 60Hz, while Peru is 220V. This means that you will require an Adapter/Converter when charging your North American apparatuses (cell phones, tablets, flat irons, etc.). We recommend getting a universal adapter and converter kit.

---

## CELL PHONE, ROAMING CHARGES & Wi-Fi

Please be aware that international cell phone roaming charges as well as long distance charges when calling from the hotel are very costly. We suggest you contact your cell phone provider prior to departure to purchase an International Talk & Text plan and/or an International Data Plan (for receiving emails). **All hotels offer complimentary Wi-Fi. The Delfin II cruise does not have Wi-Fi on board and Data services are spotty.** We therefore recommend that you disconnect and truly enjoy being in the wilds of the Amazon.

## VIDEO CREW/FILMING

We will have a small video crew with us to capture highlights of the trip, which we will then edit into 3-4 short videos as a remembrance for everyone. We will also use some of the footage for promotional purposes. They have assured us that the shoot will not interfere with or distract from your experience. If you do not mind being filmed, they have asked that you sign a release form, which they will provide (standard video protocol). Thank you for your understanding and cooperation!

Note that evenings are very cool in the Sacred Valley & Cusco due to the high altitudes. Be sure to bring comfortable walking shoes and a hat and a wrap or light jacket for evening functions. We recommend smart/elegant casual (no shorts) for the various evening functions. For those attending the cruise portion of the trip, bring cotton/linen long sleeve shirts and light weight pants for excursions.

**IMPORTANT:** Be sure to bring sun screen, insect repellent & your bathing suit! **For those joining us on the cruise, we will provide everyone with wellies (rubber boots) for our jungle walks.**

All Breakfasts, six lunches, four cocktail receptions, five dinners, and activities are included as noted in this itinerary. In-room dining, two lunches, one dinner and items of a personal nature are not included.

### GRATUITIES

8:00 a.m. VistaDome train departs Ollanta Station for Aguas Calientes. Surrounded entirely by glass with large panoramic windows offering incomparable scenic views and numerous opportunities to capture amazing pictures, travellers feel connected and part of the impressive landscape of Peru.

9:25 a.m. Arrive Aguas Calientes. From the train station we will walk to pick up our transfers that take us up to the site of Machu Picchu.

10:50 a.m. Arrive Machu Picchu

11:00 a.m. A very casual lunch will be served in the Tinkuy restaurant of the Belmond Sanctuary Lodge.

12:00 p.m. Victor, our Shaman, will be our exclusive guide and take us on a spiritual walk about this ancient site. This discovery was to become one of the greatest archaeological treasures of the 20th century. We will see the Temples of the Sun and the Moon, the Temple of the Condor, the Temple of the Three Windows, the spiritual centre of the site, the Intihuatana or the Hitching Post of the Sun and the Pachamama Rock. **NOTE: The government has recently changed the rules regarding visiting Machu Picchu: Visitors are only allowed to visit the site for a maximum of 4 hours and must be accompanied by an accredited guide. No "in & out privileges" permitted.**

We will begin by hearing about Pisco, its history, aromas and flavours and learn about the qualities that make up this unique beverage. We will then roll up our sleeves and put our knowledge to the test for a round of Pisco Sour making. For those "foodies", we will also have the opportunity to make one of Peru's most popular dishes...Ceviche. This demonstration will give you all you need to prepare a delicious Pisco Sour & Ceviche...the quintessential Peruvian beverage & appetizer.

**Learning For Hope – Visit To The San Judas Chico Girls' Home**

Located 10 mins from downtown Cusco is the Hogar de Niñas San Judas Chico, a home to about 45 girls between the ages of 4 and 17. San Judas is a place for girls whose families are unable to properly take care of them to stay. It is a safe, loving and protective home which helps provide these wonderful girls comfort and compassion as they grow. Many of the girls come from difficult backgrounds, and San Judas is all they have to call their own. We will have the opportunity to meet the girls and join them in a variety of fun and interactive activities.

In the 3 following days, you will experience an ideal combination of natural wonders, dramatic scenery, indigenous cultural history, and a relaxed self-contained way to explore the rainforest while sightseeing nature at its best. Here in the Pacaya Samiria National Reserve, you are about to explore one of the world's most intriguing environments. Flora and fauna are abundant and time seems to stand still.

For all short transport (such as from the vessel to land for hiking) and wildlife excursions, we will travel via skiff boats. The skiffs are quick to launch, stable to ride, and ready to navigate into the most hidden corners of the Amazon. Each skiff seats 8 passengers and comes with their own expert naturalist guide, captain, and features all safety equipment.

Excursions and itineraries are dependent on natural and weather conditions and are thus subject to change.

Every day, we recommend getting up early to appreciate the vibrant zones of the Pacaya Samiria National Reserve. Early rising is always rewarding since wildlife is most abundant and active with the rising of the sun.

Trail walks along the Fundo Casual Jungle Trail and others will take you deep into the rainforest on terra firme (non-flooded forest) where our guide will point out dynamic creatures and vegetation of the Amazon. A local assistant may also accompany us; these people are natives of the jungle and are able to bring you closer to different animals such as frogs, snakes, insects and maybe a sloth or two. The activity level of these walks is light; **rubber boots and rain ponchos are provided in case of inclement weather.** Be sure to keep an attentive eye open for spotting surprises!

Delfin II offers 5 Native brand 16" River Kayaks which seat 2 people. These kayaks make for excellent opportunities to paddle smoothly and silently into small creeks, tributaries, and lagoons. They have also been especially designed with durability and stability for fishing.

We will have opportunities to visit local communities, bring much needed donations and shop at handicraft markets. **Again, be sure to have Peruvian cash with you for any local purchases.**
